Players will be required to come into the facility in equipment and holding their helmet, skates & water bottle. **NO BAGS ALLOWED.** No changing area will be provided outside the skatium.

Players are required to wear a mask until their helmet goes on. Coaches are required to enforce it.

Players will be allowed to enter 15 minutes before game time and must exit immediately afterwards.

**Re:** Covid-19 Update – Ice Hockey Games

The Skatium is trying to balance COVID-19 health concerns and the urge to return to normalcy, here is our plan to scale up to current occupancy guidelines:

**Phase 1: October 9<sup>th</sup> to October 16<sup>th</sup>**

Teams only, this includes players, coaches, team managers and officials.  
Changing outside is no longer required. **No spectators will be allowed.**

**Phase 2: Starting Saturday October 17<sup>th</sup>**

The Rink will be broken into two sections.

**Section 1:** Teams only. This will also be the designated changing area for players. Locker Rooms will remain closed.

**Section 2:** Stands only. **One** spectator per player will be permitted to view the game from the stands. Masks and social distancing guidelines must be followed at all times. Spectators may not enter the area until the game starts and must exit the facility immediately afterwards to ensure proper cleaning of the stands in between games.

The Skatium reserves the right to suspend games in progress as well as the right to revert back to a “no spectator policy” if these guidelines are not followed. Subject to change as circumstances dictate.
